

Introducing the ENGMENTOR SCHEME To Mentee's

Engineers Australia – Newcastle Division



What is the purpose of the EngMentor Scheme?

The EngMentor scheme is intended to give students an idea of what the actual Engineering work place scene is like, and provide students with a contact in industry who is a practising graduate Engineer willing to assist them.

Which students may participate - how will they join the Scheme - and what is expected of them?

The scheme is for Engineering Students at tertiary education institutions located in the Newcastle Division, and is principally centred on Newcastle University. Students are invited to sign up for the scheme - indicating the areas they are interested in. Students are requested to attend the Meet Your Mentor meeting where they will hear a suggested process for the rest of the meeting, meet their mentor, discuss their interests and work out together the most useful things they can do together.

The mentor is assigned for one year. Students may sign up in more than one year.

Who will the Mentors be? And what is expected of them?

The mentors will be professional Engineers. This scheme is not limited to Engineers Australia members, and all practising engineers are welcome to act as mentors. The role of the Mentor is to provide personal experience and insights which students may not otherwise gain. Mentors are not expected to provide assistance with assignments and other course work.

It is not a requirement for Mentors to provide you with vacation employment but they may be able to guide you to areas that may be applicable to your specific interest. However if the Mentor is able to find, or even provide, vacation experience then this is a bonus.

Students wishing to participate in the EngMentor Scheme are invited to complete a Student Registration Form and forward it to the Engineers Australia Newcastle Division Office – see form for details.

Please note that this scheme is conducted on an annual cycle with a publicity campaign followed by a “Meet your Mentor” meeting in March to April each year. Registrations received outside this period will be held over until the following April.
