Engineers Australia's Individual Awards are to honour those engineers whose attributes have demonstrated great achievements and leadership within in the engineering profession.

Nominations for all Individual Awards must be submitted online via the online nomination form housed within the 'Awards' page on the Queensland Division website qld.engineersaustralia.org.au.

Nominations must be submitted to the Division in which the nominee is affiliated and supported by at least one referee who is a financial member of Engineers Australia.

Nominations close 30 June 2011.

NOMINATE ONLINE

JUDGING CRITERIA + WEIGHTING

- 30% Engineering competence
- 20% Demonstrated leadership skills
- 20% Positive/notable outcomes from engineering work
- 20% Creativity/innovation
- 10% Service to industry, the profession or the community

Nominees/nominators are required to address the judging criteria. A CV may also be submitted in further support of the nomination (optional).

CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION

- Nominees must be financial members of Engineers Australia in the relevant grade of membership at the time of nomination.
- A third party (such as an employer) can prepare a nomination on behalf of a nominee. However, at least one referee who is a financial member of Engineers Australia must support the nomination.
- Nominees must agree to the nomination by accepting the terms and conditions of the nomination in order for it to be successfully submitted. Please see the online nomination form for full conditions of nomination.
