What is Congress Online?

Congress Online is an area of Engineers Australia's website designed to give Council and National Congress members easy access to the information they most need, including meeting papers, minutes and confidential material. It is a restricted-access area of the Office Bearers and Volunteers Online website www.engineersaustralia.org.au/volunteer-support

Who can get access?

Congress Online is accessible to current Council and National Congress members, and to incoming Congress delegates whose term has not yet started. Division Presidents also have access to the site. The Executive Services Directorate staff control an electronic register which allows access to these members when they login to the Engineers Australia website.

Can I access Council and Congress papers online?

Congress Online currently contains all Council and Congress papers and minutes from May 2007 onwards. Council papers are provided a week prior to the Council meeting to allow Congress members to provide any comments to councillors prior to the meeting. Draft minutes are provided after each meeting, and are later replaced by the approved minutes.

Documents are in PDF format and can be navigated using the electronic bookmarks provided, or using the search tool.

What else does Congress Online contain?

Congress Online also contains links to other areas of Office Bearers and Volunteers Online of greatest interest to the members of Council and Congress. This provides quick access to items such as role descriptions for key roles, boards and committees, and key policy documents such as the Council Code of Practice.
