## Registration Applicant's Declaration

The National Professional Engineers Register (NPER) operates under the supervision of the National Engineering Registration Board and is maintained by Engineers Australia with integrity, on behalf of the engineering profession, in the community interest. Commonwealth or State/Territory governments in Australia may regulate an industry or activity under legislation by reference to engineering professionals on the national registers, at no cost to the community.

Consistent with National Competition Policy (NCP) Principles, Registration on NPER is open to individuals who choose not to join Engineers Australia. Applicants must have undergone competency-based assessment procedures equivalent to those of Chartered Members of Engineers Australia. The Board has also adopted Engineers Australia's Code of Ethics and Disciplinary Regulations for dealing with complaints against registrants on the National Registers.

An individual, including a member of another organisation, may apply for registration on a national engineering register without joining Engineers Australia, or may apply to become a Chartered Member of Engineers Australia at the same time. [The award of Chartered Membership enables the use of the post-nominal *CPEng*]. Registration on NPER carries with it certain obligations. All applicants for registration must sign the following declaration:

1. I have been practising competently in the area of .....for at least the equivalent of one full-time year during the past three years; and
2. I will comply with the requirements of Engineers Australia's Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Policy and will be subject to random audit of my practice and CPD records by Engineers Australia; and
3. I will be bound by Engineers Australia's Code of Ethics and subject to its Disciplinary Regulations; and
4. I consent to having my registration details (name, business contact details, current area/s of practice) published on RPSearch, the National Engineering Registration Board's online public search facility, or confirmed in any other form by Engineers Australia on request.
