- Economic growth
- Leadership

#### Criteria:

1. Your company must have an office based in NSW
2. Your company must demonstrate 4 out of the 6 categories above within NSW

J.J.C. Bradfield, the Engineer and planner, was involved in a staggering number of fields of expertise for one man. At the NSW Public Works Department he was at various times required to design roads, bridges, sewerage and public watering places; dams and other water supplies, water conservation, irrigation and drainage works, and railways and tramways. His most notable work was the design and supervision of the construction of a transport system for Sydney, including the city railway, the Sydney Harbour Bridge and the connecting roads.

NSW is currently experiencing unprecedented levels of construction, with the State and Federal Governments having invested billions of dollars in several big infrastructure projects, including the NorthConnex and WestConnex motorways, the North West Rail Link, innovative light and metro rail projects, and a new road network in western Sydney to support a second airport at Badgerys Creek. There's also the ongoing rejuvenation of Darling Harbour and the redevelopment of Barangaroo.
