

Honorary Fellows Award

Eligibility criteria and submission guidelines

These eligibility criteria and submission guidelines apply to the Honorary Fellows Award of Engineers Australia.

Who can nominate?

Nominations for this award can be made by:

- the National President and Board Chair
- Engineers Australia Board
- a division committee, college board or society board
- Engineers Australia staff on behalf of any of the above representatives.

Eligibility criteria

Eligibility for the Honorary Fellows Award is limited to:

- Fellows of Engineers Australia.
- A distinguished non-member who has rendered conspicuous service to the Australian people or the engineering profession, as nominated by the Board of Engineers Australia.

Selection criteria

Nominations must demonstrate the contributions the nominee has made in the following areas (relevant to their career):

- the community's welfare through engineering works
- the knowledge-base of the profession through research and development activities
- education through teaching and/or education support
- the community outside of engineering practice
- the profession through professional society activities
- the profession through leadership and management.

Submission guidelines

- Nominator should include their details including full name, EA membership information, phone number and email address.
- Name of the award.
- Details of the person you're nominating including their full name, EA membership details and email address.

Application requirements

- Write an executive summary about the nominee (up to 500 words). This can be cut and pasted into the online form.
- Address the nomination criteria above (up to 800 words). This can be cut and pasted into the online form.

In addressing the nomination criteria, nominators don't need to cover every aspect of the criteria. Instead choose the areas that are relevant to the nominee and their career. Demonstrate their technical expertise in business, research or education, their strong leadership in the field, world expertise or their entire body of work and how it has impacted the profession or community.

Upload

- Nominee's CV including a short bio, employment history and achievements.
- A portrait photo of the nominee.
- A 200-word citation written by the nominee highlighting their achievements and notable contributions.
