Getting your free Engineers Australia myCPD account created and linked to your EA Graduate Membership is as easy as 1, 2, 3:

1. Head to the [myCPD registration page](#)
2. Complete the registration form

The registration form includes the following fields and options:

3. Provide a valid EA membership ID and select 'Register now'

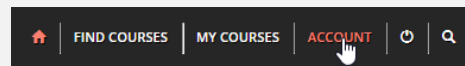
The form for linking an EA membership includes:

I already have a myCPD account

If you've already got a myCPD account setup, you just need to make sure your EA membership ID is linked up in your Account Settings:

1. [Login to myCPD](#)
2. Open the ACCOUNT page
3. Enter your EA Membership ID and select 'Update Account'



The account settings form includes the following sections:
