

Tasmania Office COVID-19 safe workplan (29/06/2020)

Given the current situation regarding COVID-19 in Tasmania it is our plan to welcome members back to the office from **July 1st 2020**.

The health and safety of our members, guests and staff is of our highest priority and we propose the following measures in addition to the State Government WHS regulations to ensure everyone's wellbeing.

Entry Conditions for Tasmania office

- Visitors to use the sanitizer station provided upon arrival
- All visitors to fill out the guest register. A new pen will be provided for all visitors to take with them
- All visitors to observe the capacity limits for all meeting rooms and members lounge

Cleaning

- Weekly deep clean undertaken by cleaning contractor
- Regular sanitisation of all common use surfaces

Food and Beverage

- Disposable cups for beverages to be used
- Disposable cutlery and crockery to be used
- No food will be provided for any visitors to the office

Signage

- The office will display adequate signing for health and safety information such as; hand washing, social distancing, do not come in if you are unwell and any other signage as required by government.
