

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q1. I am an Engineers Australia Chartered member. What do I need to provide the Ministry with, to apply for registration?**

When applying online for your Registration with the Ministry of Municipality and Environment (MME), include a scanned copy of your Engineers Australia Chartered certificate along with the other documents required for the submission. According to the MME's standard process, you will be invited to sit for the engineering exam. On the day of the examination, bring along your original Engineers Australia Chartered certificate and present it to the MME administration staff. You will then be exempted from the examination.

- Q2. Does my Chartered certificate give me exemption from other MME requirements including qualification certificates and experience letters from previous employers?**

No. The Chartered certificate only waives you from sitting the engineering exam. All other MME requirements do not change.

- Q3. I am not currently Chartered with Engineers Australia but I would like to find out more about the process. Who can I speak to?**

- Q6. Do I have to be a member of Engineers Australia to take part in local events?**

No. We welcome engineers and attendees from all backgrounds. Events are generally not restricted to EA members.

- Q7. There are a number of engineers in my company who wish to become Chartered. Are you able to provide in-house support for us?**

Yes. We are able to come to your office and provide support for a cohort of Chartered candidates.
