## 2021 ACAA CRITERIA AND PROCESS

### EVALUATION CRITERIA

#### OVERVIEW

The merits of the project entered for the Award shall be assessed on the entrant's submission and presentation of the project through the Award Evaluation process. Entrants are asked to present a case in support of their project, responding to the following Award Evaluation criteria in the same order as listed below.

#### ENTRIES AS COMPONENTS OF LARGER PROJECTS

The Award recognises that in recent years there has been a proliferation of mega projects and these projects often take many years to develop and deliver. Potential entrants should understand that size or value of project are not criteria for the Award. The Award recognises that some larger projects are delivered by way of separable components and those separable components are or could be regarded as projects in their own right that would qualify for entry for the Award. Accordingly, entrants are encouraged to give consideration to the nomination of separable component parts of larger projects, on the same basis that smaller projects exemplifying excellence ought to be nominated. However, where entrants nominate component parts of a larger project they are reminded that they should ensure that the entry provides sufficient focus on the component the subject of the entry rather than the balance of the project. While important in contextual terms, an overall project may not be considered for the purposes of assessment of the component part for Award purposes.

#### OUTCOMES ACHIEVED AGAINST PLANNED TARGETS FOR KEY PROJECT PARAMETERS (40% WEIGHTING)

What did your project achieve? The entrant is expected to have met or exceeded expectations in all key result areas (KRAs) including (as a minimum):

- Workplace Health and Safety (how the project addressed "Zero Harm" including no fatalities or permanent injuries)
- Time
- Cost
- Quality
- Environment and Heritage
- Stakeholder satisfaction
- Innovative approaches to project issues and the use and development of new technologies

Keep this factual and quantitative. Add other KRAs where relevant.

#### COMPLEXITY, DIFFICULTY AND OPTIMISATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION TASK (30% WEIGHTING)

How was this project difficult or complex? The entrant is expected to address construction complexity and how these were overcome. Examples include:

- Logistics
- Interfaces
- Constraints
- Community
- Risk Management
- Sustainability and conservation applicable to the construction project including energy savings, carbon reduction and initiatives that may support whole of life quality outcomes

#### LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT OF THE PROJECT DELIVERY (30% WEIGHTING)

Tell us how you managed to achieve your outstanding performance?

Team skills and collaboration between client, head contractor, subcontractors and a project's supply chain are increasing in importance as projects strive for excellence in achieving project outcomes. The entrant is expected to address these issues as part of the leadership and management of a project to ensure that they have delivered a project worthy of the Award. These aspects will include:

- Project team relationships
- Generating a legacy for the construction industry
- Entrant's contribution in the design process
- Workplace Health and Safety
- Planning and control of design and construction operations
- Industrial relations
- Training and development initiatives

Who was the leadership team, how did they lead in a special way, and how did the people respond to this leadership? In assessing the outcomes, the Judges will take into consideration the degree of difficulty of the construction task.



## PROCESS OF THE AWARD

- The Entrant (not being the client or principal) must have direct responsibility for the construction of the nominated project
- The project must be located within the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of Australia
- The project must be a major construction project involving engineering and/or building activities
- The content of the project must be predominantly Australian
- The project must demonstrate that it will have been substantially completed in the **twelve (12) months prior to Friday March 6, 2021**
- More than one entry may be received from any one company but entries will not be accepted for a completed project as well as an integral part of the same project
- Submissions for which entry fees have not been paid will not be considered
- The nominated project shall be made available for inspection by the Judging Panel at a mutually convenient time in May 2021
- Where any rules or conditions associated with the Australian Construction Achievement Award are disputed or require clarification, the matter shall be referred to the chairperson of the Judging Panel. The decision by the chairperson shall be final
- The Australian Constructors Association (ACA) and Engineers Australia (EA) reserve the right to retain and publish photographs, videos and other multimedia materials and descriptions of the projects entered for the Australian Construction Achievement Award
- The ACA and Engineers Australia accept no responsibility or liability regarding any loss of patent rights, other commercial privileges, or any other thing, which constitutes loss or damage as a result of entry in the Australian Construction Achievement Award

## STAGE 1 ENTRY

**STAGE 1 ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED UP TO 5PM, THURSDAY 28 JANUARY 2021.**

Entries should include the following:

- Five (5) high resolution photographs of the project
- Address all the evaluation criteria previously listed (not exceeding 2,500 words). Entrants are strongly encouraged to address the evaluation criteria in the order listed to maximise the competitiveness of their entry
- List the names and responsibilities of the project team such as (but not limited to) consulting engineers, architects, project and construction managers
- High resolution logo of the company and/or project including corporate branding guidelines
- Submit Entry online at [acaa.awardsplatform.com](http://acaa.awardsplatform.com)
- Sign Terms and Conditions in the online form
- Pay a non-refundable entry fee of \$1,100 (including GST)



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## STAGE 2 SUBMISSION

Finalists for the Award will be announced at the ACAA Launch Event on Thursday 25 February 2021. The Finalists will then be required to prepare a final submission by 5pm, Thursday 15 April 2021.

### STAGE 2 SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Description of the scope of work of the project
- Details on the type of contract used for the project
- Details with supporting examples and evidence, addressing the evaluation criteria in the order stated above, the case in support of the project that warrants the winning of the Award
- Any relevant plans and graphical or photographic material
- Names and brief biographies of the Project Leadership Team
- Ten (10) high resolution photographs of the project
- Broadcast quality video footage. Supporting video footage and photography should illustrate the development of the project from concept to completion and may include diagrams, 3D renderings, construction time-lapse videos, progress construction stills and raw or edited video footage. The video must include the project manager, or other relevant person/s involved in the management of the project, speaking about key issues that the project addressed or encountered and how those issues were addressed or overcome. This video footage will be used at the Presentation Event to showcase the project.
- Pay a non-refundable fee of \$12,100 (including a Goods and Services Tax of 10%) with the final submission.

**NB: Finalists should take care to focus on the content quality of stage 2 presentations to enable the judging panel to give appropriate recognition to project quality and outcomes.**

### TO BE PROVIDED WITH THE SUBMISSION:

- 1 to 2-minute project description. This will be used at the Presentation Event to introduce your project and video. Please ensure that this does not repeat what is said in the video.
- A technical paper on the project for inclusion on the ACAA website

**Please note: The electronic submission is to be no more than twenty (20) pages of text single sided. A4 size with no appendices, twelve (12) point font plus a maximum of ten (10) pages of photographs**

**Please note: Ownership of the photos and footage is given to the ACAA for promotional use.**

## STAGE 2 SITE INSPECTIONS

Site Inspections of Finalists' projects will be an integral part of the evaluation process. It can be assumed that the Judging Panel will inspect the project on one occasion, for approximately four (4) hours during May 2021. Subject to the evolving COVID-19 situation, and in line with government advice about travel restrictions, projects site inspection may have to be virtual. Please note:

The Finalist shall make all on-site and other local arrangements for the site inspection of the project and make available supporting data.

- The Judging Panel will expect to see other data at the same time of the inspection and a single copy of such additional data shall suffice. This would normally include detailed plans and specifications, and possibly, contract documents.
- The Judging Panel will welcome the opportunity to view relevant videos or other audio-visual material during the course of its visit. The Finalist should mention in a covering letter if material of this kind is available, the arrangements made for viewing, and the approximate time needed.
- In addition to meeting the Project Leadership Team during the inspection, the Judging Panel will expect to meet with a senior client representative. The Finalist should make the necessary arrangements.

## PAYMENT DETAILS

**Stage 1 Entries** require payment of a non-refundable entry fee of \$1,100 (including a Goods and Services tax of 10%).

**Stage 2 Entries** require payment of a non-refundable fee of \$12,100 (including a Goods and Services Tax of 10%) with the final submission.
