Calling for Nominations for the David Robinson Award

The Information, Telecommunications and Electronics Engineering (ITEE) College of Engineers Australia is pleased to announce that entries are now open for the 2017 David Robinson Award.

The David Robinson Award is presented in memory of The Institution of Radio and Electronics Engineers (IREE) and in named in honour of the late Dr David Errol Robinson AM.

The IREE represented the profession of radio and electronics engineering in Australia for many years, while David Robinson was an outstanding Australian Electronics Engineer, former President of the IREE and a world renowned expert on ultrasound technology.

Who Should Apply

Are you involved in ITEE engineering, and would \$10,000 contribute to your professional and personal development?

The award targets engineering team members at any stage of their career, and recognises significant engineering achievements during their career.

If you can demonstrate that you have made a firm commitment to your ongoing professional development, and have a well-defined professional development plan which will be facilitated by receiving the award, you should nominate. To be eligible, you will also be able to demonstrate significant engineering achievements during your career, have made significant contributions to the community beyond the scope of your employment and satisfy the eligibility criteria. You can be nominated by others, or self-nominate.

As a guideline, your professional development plan should demonstrate a historical commitment to professional development, and provide a detailed plan for your future professional development. This should address how receiving the award would enable or facilitate the realisation of your professional development objectives.

The 2017 David Robinson Award

Recognising achievement in the disciplines of Information, Telecommunications and Electronics Engineering.

A cash award of \$10,000 to aid the winner's professional development

A recipient of the David Robinson Award must:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent Australian resident; and
- be eligible to be a member of Engineers Australia in the grade of engineer, technologist or associate.

The award will be judged on the following criteria:

The candidate will meet the eligibility criteria and:

- will have made significant practical and/or theoretical contributions to the art and practice of engineering in any (or several) of the following disciplines:
 - Communications Engineering;
 - Computer Systems Engineering;
 - Electronics Engineering;
 - Information Engineering; or
 - Software Engineering,
- will have made significant contributions to the community, outside of the scope of normal remunerated employment responsibilities,
and
- will be able to demonstrate a firm commitment to their ongoing professional development.

The candidate's documented professional development plan which demonstrates how the \$10,000 cash prize will facilitate their professional and personal development.

2017 Nominations

Nominations for the 2017 David Robinson Award open on Tuesday, 1 August 2017 and close on Tuesday, 17 October 2017.
