

# Williamtown Site Safety Requirements

**During your visit to BAE Systems Australia's Williamtown site, please ensure you adhere to the following safety requirements.**

## **In the event of an alarm, fire or emergency**

- Obey all directions given to evacuate from your hosts and Emergency Wardens
- Primary evacuation point – grassed park area near Newcastle Airport
- Do not re-enter the building until advised by Chief Warden and/or Deputy Warden
- Nominated Occupational First Aiders will be in attendance with first aid kits (if required)

## **Security**

This site is under constant video security surveillance.

Posting of any BAE Systems specific operating procedures or other general information on social media is strictly prohibited.

## **Site essentials**

- **No** electronic devices are be brought on site:
  - No mobile phones
  - No cameras or photography
  - No transmitting devices (fit bits, iPads, iPods, etc.)
- All personal belongings must remain in locker or desk/office, i.e. bags, drink bottles, etc. This is to ensure no FOD (Foreign Object Damage) is taken into the hangar.
- Enclosed shoes **MUST** be worn. No open-toe shoes, sandals or thongs are permitted in the hangar or workshops at any time.
- Please stay on the blue walkways at all times and follow your hosts.
- Permission to enter aircraft bays must be received from the Team Leader.
- Eye and hearing protection will be provided to you before entering the hangar.

**If you observe a hazard on site please ensure you report it to your escort**
